Job Summary:

Provides school nursing services for students in grades

pre-k through 12.

Typical Duties:

1. Identify and provide services to students with health problems including referrals for treatment and follow-up.

- 2. Assist in emergency health or accident situations and review accident reports for follow-up.
- 3. Obtains comprehensive health history on pre-k, kindergarten, and first grade students as well as new transfers.
- 4. Reviews health records of pre-k, kindergarten, first and sixth grade students to ensure proper immunization.
- 5. Visual screening of all pre-k, kindergarten, first, third, and fifth grade students as well as teacher referrals. Referral and follow-up as needed.
- 6. Audiometric screening of pre-k, kindergarten, first, third, and fifth grade students as well as teacher referrals. Referral and follow-up as needed.
- 7. Spinal screening of all fifth, sixth, seventh, and eighth grade students. Referral and follow-up as needed.
- 8. Health Appraisals on all students with chronic health problems (i.e. asthma, diabetes, etc.) as verified by school faculty on enrollment.
- 9. Health Education and counseling at all grade levels.

- 10. Holds conferences with students, teachers, and parents when necessary.
- 11. Health assessment of staff as requested.
- 12. Community Assessment serve as liaison between the school system and community agencies as relates to health.
- 13. Environmental assessment of school site for safety.
- 14. Coordinate health related in-service activities for school personnel.
- 15. Establish innovative programs with approval. Assist in development and revision of health policies, goals, and objectives for school system.
- 16. Assist Dallas County Health Department with school based health screening program (EPSDT) at each school site.
- 17. In presence of students, display constructive health behavior patterns which will promote and encourage a healthy lifestyle.

Minimum Requirements:

- 1. Graduate of an accredited school of nursing.
- 2. Bachelor's degree preferred but not required.
- 3. Licensed by State Board of Nursing to practice as a Registered Nurse.

5. Specialization in working with children and adolescents preferred.

- 4. Minimum of three (3) years experience as a Registered Nurse.
